Criteria

- Some Entrance awards are based on specific criteria and students entering Kwantlen for the first time who meet any of the requirements of those awards, may submit this application in order to be considered.
- Eligibility criteria may include financial need, residency or graduating high school.

Instructions

- Read the award descriptions and criteria for each individual scholarship (page 2) to determine which award(s) you will apply for. You may apply for more than one award.
- Attach a personal statement which summarizes your volunteer/community involvement (supporting documentation/references must be provided), educational goals and career objectives (max. 2 pages typed, double-spaced)
- Include one letter of reference from a high school counsellor, teacher or principal supporting your application
- Provide a copy of your high school transcripts which shows final and/or interim grades of **four Grade 12 courses** (which must include English 12 or Communications 12 and one other Provincially Examinable Grade 12 course)
- Completed application packages may be hand delivered to any Kwantlen campus, or mailed directly to: Student Awards & Financial Assistance, 12666 72nd Avenue, Surrey, BC V3W 2M8, and must be received no later than **4:30 pm Wednesday, March 31, 2010.**
- Incomplete or faxed applications will not be considered

Kwantlen Entrance award recipients receive priority registration status.

Award Descriptions

Kwantlen Polytechnic University Marketing Management Entrance Scholarship

Available to students registering at Kwantlen for the first time who are enrolled in the Marketing Management Diploma program; based on academic achievement (interim high school transcripts must be submitted).

Two awards valued at \$3000 each (paid over 2 years; \$1500 each year – subject to continuance requirements)

Kwantlen Student Association Entrance Award

Available to a student entering Kwantlen for the first time who has previously been actively involved in community service (supporting documentation must be submitted). Preference will be given to a student enrolling full-time (min. 9 credits) in Community and Health Studies. Community and Health studies at Kwantlen includes Graduate Nurse Refresher, Nursing, Health Unit Coordinator, Special Education Teacher Assistant and Home Support/Resident Care Attendant. Other fields of study may also be considered.

One award valued at \$1000

***Jason R. McPhail Memorial Award**

Available to one male and one female student graduating from a Richmond Secondary school; enrolled in a business, accounting or marketing program at Kwantlen; financial need; letter of recommendation from high school teacher or counselor; interim high school transcripts. (Budget worksheet must be completed and submitted with the application form)

Two awards valued at \$1000 each

Richmond Holdings Entrance Scholarship

Available to a student graduating from a Richmond Secondary school; academic achievement; (based on interim high school transcripts submitted)

One award valued at \$900

***The Mark Catroppa and Family Kwantlen Entrance Bursary**

Mark Catroppa and his family are pleased to present an entrance bursary for a Queen Elizabeth Secondary student who is attending Kwantlen Polytechnic University in the fall. Criteria: graduating student from Queen Elizabeth Secondary; financial need. (Budget worksheet must be submitted with the application form)

Bodwell College Entrance Awards

Since 1991, Bodwell College promotes Canadian education to international students around the world. It currently has a boarding school with a capacity for 400 high school students, and a downtown campus providing university preparation program to high school graduates from overseas. The Pacific Eagles Athletics Society in conjunction with the United Surrey Soccer League is proud to sponsor an award in memory of Hardip Mann. Hardip was a leader, a visionary and always positive in promoting progressive reforms within sports. Above all, he was humble, caring and a devoted family man. He was dedicated and focused around player development rather than winning medals or trophies. He was also involved at various levels of Surrey Minor Hockey, Lacrosse and Rugby. As his own three children got involved in sports, he became a soccer coach. He never wanted to be in the limelight and always preferred to work diplomatically in the background, constantly reminding parents and coaches that "we should be focused solely on the kids and their dreams, not politics."

Hardip leaves behind a rich legacy of community service, involvement with youth sports and fight for justice and equality. He will be forever remembered for his tremendous contributions to the sports community, which words alone cannot describe. An award is to be given to a male and female student who resides in the City of Surrey. The recipients will demonstrate a true passion for sports both as participants and supporters of the power of sports within a community (supporting documentation must be submitted).

Criteria: financial need (budget worksheet must be completed and submitted with the application form); academic achievement (based on interim high school transcripts submitted); preference will be given to a SPARK student.
