Note 4: UBC requires either GEOG 2110 or GEOG 2140

Note 5: UBC requires GEOG 207, which has no equivalent at Kwantlen - however, taking GEOG 2320 will preclude having to take GEOG 306 at UBC

Note 6: SFU and UVIC require GEOG 1101 - counts as one "Arts" choice

Note 7: SFU requires both BIOL 1110 and 1210

Note 8: SFU requires either GEOG 2110 or GEOG 2120

Note 9: SFU and UVIC require one additional 2nd Year BIOL, CHEM, GEOG (from above list), GEOL 1210, MATH or PHYS

Note 10: UVIC requires two first year science courses from the same discipline, plus one other first year science

Note 11: GEOG 1160 counts as one "Arts" choice

Note 12: UNBC requires PHYS 1101 (or 1120)
