## NEW REGISTRATION RESTRICTIONS

### Applied Arts Degree Students

If you are currently enrolled in the **BAA Psychology** degree program or the **BA Community Criminal Justice** degree program, you will be given priority access to all 3000- and 4000-level PSYC or CRIM courses, respective to your program.

### Bachelor of Arts Degree Students

If you are a **Bachelor of Arts** student and are enrolled in a **Criminology, History or Psychology** program (major or minor), you must have completed the third-year entry requirements for the BA to receive priority access to your 3000- and 4000-level CRIM, HIST, and PSYC courses, respective to your program. Requirements for third-year entry into the Bachelor of Arts include\*:

- Completion of 60 credits at the 1100-level and higher
- 6-cr in ENGL 1100 and higher
- 2 of the 3 required quantitative courses
- Second language at Grade 11 level or 6-cr university-level language (in the same language)
- 12-cr of the 24-cr required breadth courses
- Math 11 or equivalent
- All required 1100- and 2000-level courses for your major or minor program
- Overall GPA of 2.00

If you are enrolled in BA programs other than those listed above or you have not yet completed your third-year entry requirements, you will be granted access to 3000- and 4000-level courses in CRIM, PSYC and HIST **shortly after the above degree students have completed their registration**. Numerous other degree courses are offered at your designated registration time without restriction.
