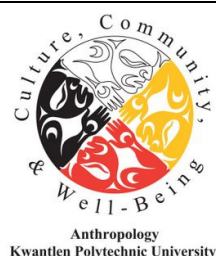

1.0 STUDENT APPLICATION PACKAGE – FIELD SCHOOL

Courses: ANTH 3301 (CRM Methods), 3340 (BC Archaeology), and 3361 (Field Studies). Twelve Credits in total. All are co-requisites.

Cost: Regular tuition plus a special fee of \$850.

Due Date: This application is due by February 11, 2011. Applications will be reviewed by the Anthropology Department. Students will be admitted to the field school based on the contents of this application and supporting documentation. Applications should be delivered to Leigh-Ann Butler (Surrey), Brian Pegg (Surrey), Ken Stark (Surrey and Richmond), or Sara Yoshida (Richmond), enclosed in an envelope clearly labelled “Field School Application”.

Application: This application is the only way to enter the field school courses. Students will not be accepted through the regular web registration process, as the field school is a selective entry program.

Students who are accepted into the field school will be required to sign a waiver form exempting Kwantlen from liability.

Required Materials Checklist:

1. Completed application
2. Completed reference from an employer (blank form is attached).
3. Selective Entry commitment fee of \$250. This fee will be applied towards the special fee for the courses. Fee will be refunded if student is not accepted. This fee should be a cheque made payable to Kwantlen Polytechnic University.
4. Copy of most recent post secondary student transcript.

Please make sure to fill out this application completely and honestly, and double check to ensure that all the required documents are present. Good luck on your application!

2.0 FIELD SCHOOL CONDITIONS

Please carefully read and sign the sheet below.

I understand that breaking any conditions outlined here may result in disciplinary action, including anything from grading penalty to expulsion (without refund) with a grade of F on all the field school courses. Disciplinary action will be determined by the field school instructor(s). By signing this sheet I accept the conditions outlined below as binding upon me.

Fitness Level and Medical: I certify that I have appropriate physical fitness and health to safely negotiate forested, uneven terrain for at least 4 km off-trail in semi-remote locations during archaeological survey, and that I am able to carry moderately heavy equipment. I will check and make sure my tetanus booster is up to date. I will disclose to the instructor(s) any medical conditions that may affect my ability to safely perform the tasks set for me in field school.

- I understand that I will be expected to work in and will be prepared for adverse weather or environmental conditions, including (but not limited to) extreme heat and sun, cold, rain, wind, insects, and wild animals.
- I acknowledge that excessive drinking, use of illegal drugs, or other illegal or unethical activities will result in immediate expulsion from the field school, resulting in a grade of F for the courses. This applies 24 hours per day while at field school.
- I acknowledge that smoking will not be permitted at any of the field school locations.
- I understand that I will be held accountable for inappropriate behaviour towards other students, instructors, community members, or the public. I accept that what constitutes inappropriate behaviour will be defined by the field school instructor(s).
- I accept sole liability for any forest fires that may be started as a result of any of my activities during the field school. I will not light fires of any sort in any location except one identified as safe by the field school instructor(s).
- I accept that should I be expelled from the field school, I must leave immediately at my own expense. I accept that if I drop the field school courses, I will not be refunded my special fee.
- I accept that I will be responsible for replacement costs should I damage or lose any field, lab, computer, or classroom equipment or resources loaned to me by Kwantlen, regardless for the reason for the damage.
- I accept that I have responsibility for the cleanliness of my camping, cooking and eating area. I understand that failure to keep these areas clean may result in sickness or injury, and accept the liability for this.
- I will follow all instructions given by the instructor(s).
